I have been waiting for a week for a lab result. I was contacted by a customer service manager but of course, my call was not returned as expected by Planned Parenthood. I have given up on making any progress with them. I now will have to switch to a new provider, order the same test, and wait for the result again..



3/22/2018 - Previous review

I've recently switched to Melody as my primary healthcare provider. I came in yesterday to have a check-up for my throat (I got the correct diagnosis after visiting the ER the following day). When I sat down, I was helped by the most clueless and insensitive medical assistant. I was in excruciating pain and she showed no sympathy as she told me that the reason for my visit was a follow up for my breast ultrasound so therefore the physician can only address that concern. I was infuriated. She proceeded to take my ear temperature without actually inserting the device in my ear... I believe she took the room temperature correctly. I was then seen by a PA named Nhi who was unable to provide a diagnosis for my throat (it's strep). She had the same medical assistant take a sample from my throat to test for strep, which came back negative. I have gotten strep several times before in the past and know that sometimes the test result can be a false positive. She was unable to give me a definitive diagnosis and proceeded to prescribe me muscle relaxant... and told me to keep taking ibuprofen even though I specified that I have been taking ibuprofen for the past 5 days and the symptoms have not gotten better. I woke up this morning with extreme pain and was so fed up with this visit and how unhelpful it was. I took myself to St. Josephs ER where I was diagnosed with strep by a simple visual examination. The PA at the ER was shocked to hear about my experience at Planned Parenthood and the lack of professionalism and competency from the staff. For those who are thinking of switching to Melody, please don't because you are better off saving your time and energy and emotion going to the ER or a healthcare provider with sufficient medical knowledge to actually be able to help you get better.







Let me start with the fact that I have never written a negative review in my whole life. I don't like to complain and no one messes up that bad to urge me to write one.

I have been going to planned parenthood for 10 years with zero problems. I had my Mirena put in 3 years ago and loved it until recently it was giving me issues. So last week I made an appointment to have it checked out. The front desk staff is awesome, they want you in as soon as possible and they care that you have all the info. you need about your insurance so there aren't any money surprises. I waited in the patient room after getting checked in for over an hour. Not a crazy huge deal until I hear the girls outside cleaning up and saying good night to each other! I stepped out and grabbed someone to get a doc. or else I was obviously leaving. The doctor comes in and is SO short with me and my questions. She came off as annoyed and everything I asked was quickly dismissed as if I didn't know what I was talking about. Ive had this thing in my body for 3+ years, I know that something isn't the same. She tells me to take a Tylenol and change sex positions. She leaves and I get dressed and wait for her to come back with test results. Another 15 minutes and I stick my head out and a different woman comes around surprised to see me and asks what I'm waiting for. Are you kidding me? She goes and gets my test results in 2 seconds as if they were just sitting forgotten on the counter.

At this point I'm flustered, but I trust the doctors, so what can ya do.

Skip to a week later with no change in my severe cramping and sharp pains so I make another appointment (earlier in the day, so I hope I am not easily forgotten) to have the Mirena removed. Went in yesterday and SAME THING. Front staff is awesome.

Then, I literally watch my nurse roll her eyes and laugh under her breath not once, but 3 times, about my concerns. The doctor took the Mirena out and didn't answer any of my MANY questions about the new pill she wanted to prescribe me to instead of the IUD. She simply gave me a new prescription, said it was the best, told me to sign, get dressed, and good to go.

Needless to say, they don't seem to care at all. I have excellent insurance and still chose to go here instead of a new place. Won't make that mistake again.

My husband told me to throw the pill prescription she gave in the trash and make an appointment with a "Real Doctor."

Also, INSTANT relief once the Mirena was removed. No pinching when I sit or non-stop cramping/ sharp pains through out the day. I have no clue what changed, but I'm glad I listened to my body instead of those egotistical women.

(Who don't make it feel even a little bit like a "welcoming safe-place")

I went back in because it was painful where they inserted it and it was still bleeding. The dr saw me for 2 secs and told me that If I am still in pain in a week to come back

It makes me sad that I have to say this cause I love what PP does for women. But when I have a busy work schedule i have very little time to get into a doctors. I know exactly what is wrong with me and they failed to test me properly. If anyones ever had a UTI its painful ive already had it for two weeks but I guess ill wait another week thanks to the lazy staff they have on sundays. I wouldnt suggest going on weekends guys. YOU HAD ONE JOB! Especially in the medical feild do your job right or dont do it at all







I've been to this PP five times now and each time has been different. A couple times I had consultation for an IUD insertion, another for pregnancy and STI screenings and those were standard fine appointments. No complaints.

When I had my IUD inserted, my doctor was quite cold with me and fast. I had expressed fear and she didn't reassure me much and it felt like she just wanted to get it over with and move on. After the insertion it was very painful and I felt like I was going to pass out and she said "that's normal. Here's some apple juice and you can get up and leave whenever you are ready." And left right away. It all just felt very cold and hard for me being alone. After that, I experienced a lot of pain for a while (which I know is normal.) I went to a follow up appointment to check to see if everything still looked good. It did and that doctor was SO kind and reassuring. Honestly the nicest lady ever (a different doctor from the one who inserted it) A week later I was in a lot of pain and wanted to come back in to make sure it was still all good and she was my doctor again and was again super kind and reassuring and listened to me and invited me to come back any time I felt things aren't right. She gets 5 stars from me.

Fast forward now over a year and I've been experiencing very troubling pain that is definitely not normal for quite a while now (not IUD related). I came in today to get looked at and while the doctor herself was very kind and professional, I felt as though I was talking to a wall. I'd tell her all the details and she'd come back with "that's normal" and I would say it wasn't normal for me and I am here because it's not normal. She only wanted to do a couple basic tests which I agreed to but when she said "everything's normal!" Despite me saying "this hurts" during the exam (not normal for me). I said I felt like if she didn't feel anything maybe we could do an ultrasound because again THIS ISN'T NORMAL, but she insisted that it seemed fine and I could come back another time if I felt I needed more. I don't know. I needed more now, that's why I made the appointment. I appreciate her being kind and trying to reassure me that I was okay, but ultimately, I came in there fully prepared to do some bigger exams because I know what I'm feeling isn't right. I wasn't prepared to have to advocate for myself so much and wished my doctor had listened to me more seriously.







I had an appointment for 11am. Writing this review at 11:55 and still have not seen a doctor. I had high hopes for this location but now I know I need to find a real PCP at a real hospital. I feel like the normal planned parenthood stuff gets you in and out but the MELODY healthcare always takes up 2 hours of my day. TWO HOURS to get some cream for my eczema? No thanks.







Planned Parenthood is supposed to be low or free cost to low income individuals. Long story short: I needed to have a mammogram done w/in 24 hrs to comply with my medical requirements. It was almost 4pm so there was no way to get it done that day. My doctor office did not open until 10am, so just as PP opened its doors at 7am the next morning, I went in to get a referal for an mammogram. There was only one other person who came in with me, and I was to told it would not be seen until sometime in the afternoon, and that I was required to pay for the consultation now at the cost of \$240.00. I was shock! \$240 for a consultation to get a referal for an mammogram, and they receive grant/funding from the government? My doctor regular consultation is only \$75, but he only charges me \$35 as I have not health insurance.

PP is a rip-off organization, anti-community, and anti-low income. The only free service that they provided while I was there, was given out free condoms to some pre-teens or early teens kids, who came in and requested condoms. Wouldn't they should require these kids to take a safe and responsible sex workshop before passing out condoms like candies?

PP have lost my respect as a community organization. I had a pap smear at a community clinic once. It was free, and I only had to wait less than an hour to be seen.

This is the worst location I've ever been to! During COVID, patients have to do a drive thru appointment. I got to my appointment and got called in to take my STI test. They had me wait in my car for my doctor to have a FaceTime appointment with me. 40 minutes go by and my doctor still didn't call me. I had my AC on because it was hot outside. My car was running out of gas so I went to a gas station that was literally 1 minute away and came back right away. They called me and told me since I left, I would have to cancel my appointment. No one told me that If I left the drive way I'd have to reschedule. Especially If I was already back! Mind you I have major symptoms. Obviously my health is not important to them because they threw my test away just because I left for a few minutes. I was already back my when they called me. I told them I was parking and they said "parking? Oh you left? We're gonna need to reschedule." Don't come to this location I'm begging you. They are so rude and do not respect the appt time. The dr will have you waiting in your hot car almost an hour over your appt.





5/22/2021

I have visited Planned Parenthood - Westminster for the last five years and every time they all went great. The two Vietnamese receptionists are always welcoming and willing to answer any questions that I have.

However, I guess today is not a lucky day for me. I scheduled the Well Women Exam today at 10AM. I arrived at 9:45. Checked in using the link they sent. Waited 20' and finally received a call from them to check in. A female nurse called to inform me that I cannot have the exam today because I just did one in July of last year. Since I didn't remember exactly when was the last time I got the exam, so I said to her it was okay if I couldn't get the Well Women Exam today but I would like to discuss with someone about some side effects with the birth control that I am using right now. I just wanted to know if there are any other options for me to avoid these side effects. It's that simple. Instead making me feel welcome and comfortable to express my concerns about my health. Her attitude is just making me more and more uncomfortable to the point I decided to hang up the phone. I asked for her name but she didn't answer me.

I wasted 2 hours. My morning was ruined and I got no answers for my questions. Great!

I was currently waiting after I made an appointment to be seen 45 mins ago. Everyone who came after I did is already seen. I asked if it would take any longer and they said not long. After they eventually took me inside, the girl said that I had to go back outside and wait because there was no rooms available. Whoever runs this place needs to make sure these girls have a sense of urgency and take people inside in order.

9/23/2017

I wouldn't recommend this place. Very unwelcoming and uncomfortable experience. I used to go here but the service has gone down hill over the years. I don't know why I bothered coming back, but gave it another shot because I went to the walk-in in Orange and they recommended me to go to an open appointment in Westminster. During my last appointment there, I was treated disrespectfully and unprofessionally. The person who saw me looked young like maybe she was in training. I asked for other services and she became frustrated and visibly irritated. Then said I should have let her known earlier so it doesn't waste her time. She complained about having to go back into the computer to do things all over again. Never heard of someone in the medical profession complaining about doing more work to a patient. This was the first.

Um excuse me? Waste your time? One, this is your job to do the work. You think your job is to get angry and frustrated doing more work and taking it out on a patient? Two, this isn't some therapy session to show your behaviors and attitude. Three, ever heard of people in the medical profession who do their job right say, "is there anything else I can help with?" You don't like doing the work that irritates you helping people, why be in that field? I wouldn't mind so much if she told me about making it easier on the staff without the attitude, but unfortunately this wasn't the case. Will not be coming back.







Well, big surprise I had another terrible experience here. The nurse practitioner refused to prescribe me a pill I'd been on for nearly 20 years, at their recommendation I'd switched to a different pill for a few years. WOW! Even the docs at HOAG/Greater Newport Physicians had prescribed the pill I prefer...but I don't have health insurance right now...Thanks Planned Parenthood for not allowing me to the right to "choose" a particular contraceptive and for kicking me while I'm down so to speak.





I sat in the waiting room for 1 hour before I went up to the front desk to ask why I hadn't been seen yet. I figured hey, it's planned parenthood not a real doctor's office so maybe this is a standard wait. They said my medical group on my health insurance card had changed since I made the appointment and to go see an ob in my medical group or my Primary Care Physician.

Thanks guys! Could you have told me before I sat in the waiting room for an hour?

I'm adding the following: After a few days and some after thought, I don't even think they're allowed to have denied me services like that. They said I would need to pay \$159 for the standard routine female checkup in which I was asking for and that I should go see my ob or primary care physician. They literally REFUSED to see me. In the meantime several 20 year olds were told no big deal if they couldn't afford to make a donation or pay and \$\$, and they were still seen. Complete BULLSHT.







Service from main office staff was fine. I was second in line since I came in right as they opened. It took 30 minutes to be seen.

I don't remember her name (oh if only I could remember!), but one of the doctors was very belittling. I came to take out my implant since it was causing mental instability, and she scoffed and said in a very condescending tone,"it's not the implant that's causing that. There's no mental side effects with the implant. It's probably you." I know for a fact it was the implant because before and after I had it, I was fine. While using it, I was crazy with anxiety/depression/mood swings. Everyone I knew noticed. Even on the pamphlet in the office it says "rare side effects: mood swings, anxiety, depression," etc. She then asked what I was going to use instead. I said condom since there's no hormone in that. She again laughs and says, "so you're going from the best contraception to the worst? ... OK." It's only a one percent difference in effectiveness. Judgemental. Condescending, Ignorant. Rude.

This visit was months ago and look at me! Using condoms and not pregnant!

But I didn't mind the first two times because I needed a blood test and a pap smear, so I assumed the experts in those areas were busy & I needed to wait.

This time I only needed to refill my birth control pills.

My appointment time was 12:15pm.

I got there at 11:50am. I waited in the waiting room for an hour, and they called some people who arrived after me in first. After I was called in, they weighed me, then told me to wait in a room for a nurse to come in.

I was in there for OVER AN HOUR! During this time, I can hear them call over seven different people in.

I went out to say, "I'm sorry, but how much longer will it be before a nurse sees me?"

Before I could even finish asking, the rude nurse/doctor/staff memeber cut me off and walked away!

Like wth.

Then the nurse finally went in and gave me my pills and asked for my signature on a form. That was it!

LESS THAN THIRTY SECONDS!

I waited over two hours just for the nurse to see me for thirty seconds!

WTF!

What's the freaking point of having an appointment if I have to wait over two hours for something that takes less than one minute???

I had an appointment less than a month ago for a check up and to set up birth control for myself. I had already been on that pill for a long time so it was no problem and a total breeze. I only got one package for that time being. I just called to try and schedule a pick up for more birth control and was told I needed to see a clinician first.

I said, "But I just had a check up with one less than a month ago. I still need to meet with a doctor just to pick up birth control?" "Yes."

I'm sorry, but how on earth does that make sense? Why would I get a check up less than a month later just to get birth control pills. And after I was told it will be much cheaper than picking up at a pharmacy...not if they charge me for ANOTHER appointment. Oh, and I also don't have the time to spare an hour out of my time every few months just to get some packages of pills.





8/10/2016

Went to this location as I needed my BC soon and there wasn't an available appointment at the Orange location. Upon going in with an appointment, I ended up still waiting 30 min to be called in. No big deal. People get backed up and I understand. However, the MA that roomed me looked way unenthusiastic as if she hated her job. The entire interaction with her was so hard to endure, she was monotone, never looked you in the eye, didn't seem like she cared. After she left, a male RN came in. At least he was courteous and seemed like he actually cared about a patient's well-being. After my initial assessment, it was decided that the NP (Hashimoto) come in to see me instead, so again I waited. Which the wait still didn't bother me. However, when the NP came in, she also didn't seem to care much about my concerns. All she did was ask the normal questions regarding signs/symptoms I was having and wanted to push me out the door. Towards the end, she just rushed me to sign the form on the computer screen and had the male RN bring me my BC. Overall, my visit there was 'unremarkable' as the say. I don't expect 5 star treatment but at least some sort of compassion when working with patients. What really prompted me to write this review was not my visit there, but what occurred after. My main concern going in was for a possible UTI, and as expected they should call you with your results if they are abnormal. I didn't find out about my abnormal results until many days later, not from any staff, but through the online portal. So upon viewing them, I called to find out what went wrong in terms of communication and what my next steps at this point should be. First attempt at calling, the girl told me I supposedly was informed of my results at the visit which was entirely false. Keep in mind the NP never went over my urine dip results with me and rushed me to sign the form to get me out. Also, there was no way she could have informed me when the time stamp in which she reviewed the results was AFTER I had left the clinic. To top it off, the girl I was speaking to was very adamant about me having gotten my results in clinic, enough to say I must have forgotten then hung up on me. No. I'm sure I am still young enough to have my noodles intact to remember an encounter or any discussion regarding my health status. Please keep in mind I was never rude on the phone. I had simply just wanted to find out where it went wrong and where I should go about my abnormal results. Second attempt at calling again (~1710), at least this rep was more professional about it, however, still unable to direct me to someone who could resolve this as it was too 'late' in the day and they are about to close. She told me to call in the morning to see if I could 'possibly' talk to someone who could help me in regards to the abnormal results. It has been exactly 12 days since my visit, still experiencing symptoms (not including previous weeks of having same symptoms) with no plan for treatment and the possibility for further concern based off of my abnormal results. To be continued as I will call in the morning to see what happens.

I came to get tested for an infection as I was feeling uncomfortable down there. The nurse that attended me was super kind and friendly and I really loved how bubbly and kind she was. Everything was flowing smoothly until it a urinary problem which I don!! I had redness on my lower abdomen and I took a pic because I was came to waiting half naked with a paper sheet to cover my lower body. I waited in there for so long the lights turned off on me. A minute later after the lights turned off on me the doctor comes in. She did on me! said hello and everything and even complemented me on my dress etc. when it came down to using the speculum in my genitals she kept manhandling my Vna!! She kept pressing real hard on my lower abdomen and she kept telling me to relax! Her name is Heather and she is Caucasian doctor. She was having trouble inserting the speculum becauSe I was tense and uncomfortable and she just rammed her fingers and speculum into my walls completely disregarding my comment about it hurting. When she had her fingers inside I could feel her long nails and I was just tense and tight and could not relax. She was not very kind and was sounding extremely rude and talking to me as a 12 year old and I am 21! I am a grown woman!! Before the manual exam down there she was asking me very rudely why I haven't gotten my period yet and what kind of method for contraception I was on. Hoping to be seen. Thank goodness they took me because I had no symptoms of Covid, Supposedly they have emergency calls but I sure didn't get any service when I needed it. So today I

wanted to make an appointment to test for Covid. Nope, no testing there. Neither do they do for Herpes which IS an STD. So what do you do? That's right, give birth control. I bet you give the Covid 19 Vaccine when it arrives! LOL What's the point of having Health Insurance when they wont help you in any way. Go else where and save yourself time. Good luck!



11/20/2020

I went here for a first time check up for an sti. The nurses at the receptionist and the nurse who called me in were very sweet and kind and I really appreciate this one nurse that made me feel welcomed and talked to me through everything she was doing to make sure I knew what was going on. The doctor who did the check up/procedure on me was this blond lady who made me feel uncomfortable. She had to use the speculum on me but I told her it was painful and I kept moving but she told me to stop and didn't listen to me when I said that it hurt multiple times. It was such a stressful and uncomfortable experience and I would be scared to book another appointment because I might get her again. Also to note, the nurse told me to get a HIV/hepatitis/blood test since it was free and I told her yes. The blond doctor saw on the report that she gave me a blood test and kept mumbling about how the nurse was doing unnecessary stuff and it seemed like she was cursing the staff under her breathe. Overall, I would come again but only if that bitchass doctor won't be there.





10/7/2019

The NPs and nurses here are so judgmental and egoistic. I came in to have my implant removed after over a year. The implant stopped my period completely and since then I've also lost my sex drive, extremely dryness and pain when intercourse. Before my period stopped, there were many spotting too and I had to wear liner everyday. Came in to see a Dr/NP, didn't catch her name but she was a short Asian lady. I proceeded and told her that yes, I did use lube but for god's sake it didn't help, and the sex was unbearable I always feel like the inside of me is being torn off, yet all she can offer was to again "use lube" and "relax." She giggled and smiled after every questions I have and have the nerve to ask how old I was. Unprofessional, didn't care about the patient and made them feel disrespected. She may be good at whatever she's doing but I definitely know my body better.

The other time I checked in to have my third HPV shot, after a long wait I got called and waited inside the room, the MA later stepped in. I'm not always looking at people's name tag, and didn't hear any introduction from her either so I didn't know her name, but she was a pretty young Mexican girl. After I've answered all the questions and as she was still typing on the computer, I took my phone out to see a new text message. She immediately responded, in a really loud-annoyed voice "PLEASE KEEP YOUR PHONE AWAY WHILE IN THE EXAM ROOM!!!". Like excuse you? She freaked me out and that was so uncalled for. So rude. She left 3 mins after without further questioning with a really grumpy face and made me feel super uncomfortable.
