I was then sent in a room with an MA named Jessica who was very sweet and then asked a series of personal questions, I then was taken to a bathroom that was very gross and told to leave my sample there. Once going to the waiting room I was then asked to pay \$292 UPFRONT. From the same person who said I could do the reimbursement. She was asking her lead if there were any payment plans and her lead was very nasty and didn't say anything and just shook her head no. So not only did I waste my time getting there but now they had to toss my sample out. It was very degrading being that I was very concerned for my health and now I'm being turned away because of my inability to pay! On Planned Parenthood its says "Our fees are based on your household income. We'll never turn you away from the care you need because of your inability to pay". That was a lie in my case. DO NOT WASTE YOUR TIME.

Not only is the customer service terrible (and fraudulent) but they took their sweet time with an 11 am appointment. I was there until 12:15pm and the last 15 min was just waiting to pay the bill. Then once I paid and expressed my dissatisfaction with the pricing, the woman in the billing department laughed at me for being upset with the clearly false prices Planned Parenthood staff communicated to me.

I will never go here again. I do not recommend it. My bill stated that they charged me \$135 just for being a "new patient." I fully support Planned Parenthood. But don't come here if you're at all atypical and need a Mirena.

What should have been a simple 40 min appt turned into a traumatic, plus 2 hour incredibly painful ordeal.

To start they ask for an insurance card, so they can see what you're approved for. 30 min into my visit, I'm told none of what I'm doing is covered, and it will be over 3K. After my shock and politely asking they check again, *Surprise* everything is covered. (This changes yet again later to a co-pay because of additional services).

I can hear the staffers in the hallway asking around to multiple other staffers if they have the medical device and talking about my visit. This continue throughout my visit as I'm left repeatedly, even when I'm undressed.

I'm upfront about my need for a removal and replacement of my current Mirena to help with my endometriosis and all it's complications. And why it's the only option I'm able to tolerate.

My medical professional spends our entire visit asking & asking if maybe there could be any other reason I could be suffering from endo symptoms again and that maybe I don't really want to remove/replace it.

I do all the extra services just to make her comfortable and prove that it's the endo/mirena and not anything else. This causes the visit to be even more expensive.

The Mirena removal goes smoothly and then to my horror she announces that she's not comfortable doing the replacement due to my atypicalness. So we stop and I get dressed.

She wants to go over -again- all my other options. I finally impress upon her that this is truly my only viable option but she's not comfortable doing it.

So, not only did I not get what I came for - I'm actually in worse health than when I came in, because now there is nothing to stop/mitigate my incredibly debilitating disease. I'm also in a great amount of pain from the procedures and left scrambling to try to find another provider.

If she wasn't comfortable doing an insertion in the first place - for whatever reason - she should have said so before she removed the existing one.

It turns out that my cousin had a very similar experience with the PP in San Jose in Oct 2019. She actually had to get a lesser effect implant in her arm.

The physicians are great, but I have been in here twice now and both times the front desk people never really seem to know what the hell they are doing and it's very frustrating. I just went in today because I had an appointment to get my IUD looked at, as I was having some complications that concerned me. I had some issues with my insurance last time I was in, so I was sure to mention that when I came in, and then asked if I needed to help her clarify any information. She said that at my last visit I was told I needed to contact my insurance, and then asked if I did so. I said no, because no one told me I needed to contact my insurance at my last visit, and I shouldn't have to-you literally just have to bill the receipt to my insurance and then they take care of it from there. But after waiting 40 minutes, the lady told me that my Aetna insurance wasn't going to cover my visit, and that I would have to pay in full. They also said this about my last visit, when I got the IUD inserted, so I had to pay \$400 out of pocket because this place literally doesn't know how to bill insurance companies. The lady kept insisting that it wasn't them, it was my insurance, but that was proven to be false. I have contacted my insurance company and have already been told to submit reimbursement paperwork so that

I can get my money back, because they DO cover what I came in for the past two times I've been to this Planned Parenthood. So now I have to go out of my way and fill out extra paperwork just because the ladies at the front have no idea how to bill insurance. I was so frustrated that I couldn't afford to get the care I needed to get today because these people don't know how to do their job, that I walked out in a fluster and cried in anger in my car before driving home.

I have been to other Planned Parenthood's before and have literally never had this problem. They just took down my ID numbers for my primary and secondary insurance, and then sent the bill to them after my visit, and then my insurance would then bill me what was left over-Easy and simple. Don't know why it appeared to be an issue here.

On top of that the place is not well kept and looks trashy. If you scheduled an appointment with this Planned Parenthood I recommend trying somewhere else.

I needed to see a Dr. for something simple, waited 45 minutes in line, only to be turned away. Make an appointment!

When booking an appointment, you don't talk to someone from this specific clinic but a person from an answering service. That in itself is incredibly impersonal. They don't care if you can't be seen same day, and are in pain (aka not enough pain to go to ER but not enough to ignore). They are not your neighbors.

When it came to insurance, the woman who fielded my call led me under the false impression that I was qualified for FamilyPACT, which would of covered my costs. I was absolutely wrong! I was required to submit appeals, do pre-verifications of insurance, and call insurance companies and stay on the phone for hours in regards to denied claims. I did WAY too much for what a medical biller should be doing and was Paid WAY too low for doing it. The hardest part of the job was the constant micromanagement. It seemed as if we were being called into the office every day because we were not collecting enough money. Are we not supposed to be a non-profit? why are we sending these patients who can't afford healthcare to collections? Why are we selectively using government funds when were supposed to be using them for more? In the end it was all about money, money, money which I had a hard time understanding because we were supposed to be a "non-profit" and serve all no matter what, not send them to collections. I mean our CEO made 400,000 a year. come on? why are we still sucking patients dry? Overall, the company had a GREAT inclusive culture. As an LGBTQIA+ individual, I felt very accepted at the organization and was very included in everything. What I did not like was the micromanagement and the constant pressure to collect.
